BTST By ANT (INVITE)

User Manual

This manual explains how to use the BTST By ANT (INVITE) strategy in a simple and practical way. Please read fully before using the tool.

1. What This Tool Is

BTST By ANT is a research-based strategy designed to study Buy Today Sell Tomorrow (BTST) behaviour. It works by analysing the 3:15 PM candle **on a 5-minute chart** and observing how price behaves the next trading day.

This is NOT a guaranteed trading system and should be used only for learning, testing, and analysis.

2. Supported Assets (IMPORTANT)

This tool works best on:

- Indian Equity Stocks
- Indian Indices (NIFTY, BANKNIFTY, FINNIFTY, etc.)
- Index derivatives (for directional study only)

It may NOT work properly on:

- Crypto markets
- Forex pairs
- International markets with different trading hours

Reason: The strategy depends strictly on Indian market timings (3:15 PM close and 9:20 AM next day open).

3. Mandatory Chart Settings

Before using the strategy, ensure the following:

- Timeframe: 5 Minutes ONLY
- Exchange Timezone: As per the exchange (India)
- Do not change market hours

Using other timeframes or incorrect sessions may give wrong results.

4. How Entry Works (Simple Explanation)

- The strategy checks the market ONLY at 3:15 PM.
- It compares the normal candle close with the Heikin-Ashi style close.
- Based on candle direction and price behaviour, it decides:

- Gap Up (Buy Today)
- Gap Down (Sell Today)
- Skip Today (No Trade)

Only ONE decision is taken per day.

5. Visual Labels Explained

- Gap Up / Gap Down: Indicates the BTST bias decided at 3:15 PM
- Skip Today: No clear setup, no trade should be considered
- PARTY: Next day behaviour aligned with expectation
- LOST: Next day behaviour did not align

These labels are for study and review, not for trade confirmation.

6. Exit Logic

- Stop Loss and Take Profit are percentage-based and user-defined.
- If neither SL nor TP hits, the strategy force-exits at 9:20 AM next trading day.

This exit rule exists to control overnight risk.

7. Best Practices for Users

- Always backtest before any real usage
- Use small quantities if testing live
- Avoid trading on event-heavy days
- Do not use blindly without market context
- Combine with higher timeframe trend understanding
